Invictus - William Earnest Henley

Your sense of identity determines your destiny

Starting Point for our Identity:

- 1) This is God's Story
- 2) We are Created

Genesis 1:26-27 - Being made in God's image shapes our identity...

1. You Have Value

Your value is not conditional on the approval or acceptance of others.

2. You Have Purpose

We were created to bring God glory (make him famous).

3. You Have a Need

In each of our hearts is the silent cry to know our creator.

Conclusion: Child of God

John 1:10-13

How to take on God's identity:

- 1) Repent
- 2) Remind
- 3) Rest

Life Group Discussion

Warm up:

- 1. Have you ever placed your identity (even a small part) in something as ridiculous as a beard? If so, what?
- 2. What is something more serious that you place your identity in? (i.e. performance, work, family, etc). Why is it so important to you?

Study & Discussion:

- 3. Read Genesis 1:26-27. There is so much more to being made in the *imago Dei* than what Pastor Joe shared on Sunday. What does being made in the image of God mean to you? How does this shape your sense of identity?
- 4. Read John 1:10-13. Being a child of God is just one of the many names that God gives believers. How does being a child of God shape your sense of identity? How is it different from *the Image of God?* What other God-given names shape you? Why are they significant to you?
- 5. Read Matthew 3:8; Matthew 4:17; Luke 5:31-32. Why is repentance such an important theme in Jesus' preaching? Is it possible to do nothing morally wrong and still have a rebellious heart? Do you think it is important to repent of false identities? Why or why not? What do you think of repentance being defined as: "turning from something to someone?"

Application:

- 1. What false identity do you need to repent of?
- 2. This week: how will you remind yourself of who God says you are?
- 3. This week: when will you <u>rest</u> in God's presence to let him speak life to your soul?

Prayer:

- 1. Pray that God would give each of us a *game changing* moment in our sense of identity. That we would see ourselves as God sees us.
