Text: Judges 2:6-10; Acts 17:16-34; Mark 2:13-17

Intro: Meet Generation Z

- Born between 1995-2010
- Influenced by rapid changes in technology, sexuality, family and gender.
- Largest "religious" group is "None".

Judges 2:6-10

There are <u>barriers</u> that we can tear down to make room for the next generation:

1. The Curse of Knowledge

The Curse of Knowledge - The assumption that we are communicating because we have inside information.

Acts 2 vs. Acts 17 approaches. Speak in a language that culture understands.

Explanation is the new evangelism.

2. Fear of Rejection

Invitation actually works. Fear holds us back from putting ourselves out there.

In Acts 9:26-27 Barnabas took a chance on Saul. Be like Barnabas and take a chance on a young person.

3. Not Letting Go

In order for faith to be real it must be lived. We must let go and train the next generation in areas of responsibility.

"What is the faith of the next generation worth? I say it is worth everything" - Andy Stanley

- 4. Read Mark 2:13-17. Meditate on Jesus' response. How much should church be about "the righteous"? How much should it be about "the unrighteous"? Why do you think that? Do your actions match your answer?

Application:

1. What simple and practical steps will you take *this week* to make room for the next generation?
